Raising Fraud Awareness

I am writing to you in your capacity as Clerk to the Town or Parish Council, to advise you of Suffolk Coastal District Council's efforts to reduce the threat of fraud against its finances, and to seek your Town / Parish Council's cooperation and support in this respect.

Nationally, fraud (and in particular benefit fraud) is estimated as costing Local Government over £100 million per annum. In comparison with other Local Authorities Suffolk Coastal has sustained comparatively few losses from fraudulent activity, however, we are not complacent and remain committed to safeguarding our finances and the public services they fund. Our dedicated counter-fraud service, the Corporate Counter Fraud Unit, is currently examining how we can further reduce losses from fraud by improving how we deter, prevent and detect all forms of fraudulent activity committed against us.

As Town and Parish Councils are at the heart of the community, we are asking for your suggestions in terms of how we can better promote our antifraud message and are asking whether you would like us to forward to you a number of publicity posters (available in A3 and A5 size) advertising our fraud hotline telephone number.
